General Discussion

Hans Peuker is going to be showing us some techniques on covering.



The secret to the best covering job is in the preparation. You must sand the surface first. Vacuum all dust and then use a tack cloth to further remove the dust that the vacuum did not pick up. Read the temperature requirements of the covering material and set your iron to their recommendation. I like to cover my iron with a cotton sock to prevent damage to the covering. Then we start at the corners and work your way in. At first you just want to tack the covering to the wood and then seal the perimeter. If it is a wing that you are working on do this to both sides before shrinking the covering. By doing this there is less likelihood of wing warping. Take your time and shrink the covering evenly on both sides.
