(Blair) Brian had mentioned to me on several occasions that he had a Biron F16 in his basement that he couldn't see himself ever finishing. I thought that this would be an interesting project to see how it would fly with an electric package. So this past year when we went down to Toledo I purchased a Turbox electric ducted fan unit for it and the project began. Since then I have put in a 110 amp 9cell lipo setup which gives me 4000 watts of power at 32000rpms. I am using Hitec sevos throughout and a spectrum 7 radio. The whole package weighs 13.5 lbs. I have finished it in Danish Colours.
